All he can do is double click, opening it. With no way to close it, other than quitting Qgis entirely.

And still no way to delete it via the menus.

Starting up again, he single click a Recent Project, highlighting it, but then in Project->Properties we only learn about a project without a file. Why isn't this greyed out if we are not supposed to chose it?
