<p>User upon starting, sees "Recent Projects" with no way to right click to delete one.</p> <p>All he can do is double click, opening it. With no way to close it, other than quitting Qgis entirely.</p> <p>And still no way to delete it via the menus.</p> <p>Starting up again, he single click a Recent Project, highlighting it, but then in Project->Properties we only learn about a project without a file. Why isn't this greyed out if we are not supposed to chose it?</p>
