## QGIS is lagging after a few saves in PostGIS layers

<p>In Kubuntu 14.04 after a few editing rounds on PostGIS layers QGIS starts to lag until it becomes unresponsive. I need to kill the application and start over. All data is saved correctly. But, when checking my Postgresql log I could get this: "could not receive data from client: Connection reset by peer" This means that the QGIS's connection is getting broke in same way.</p> <p>This happens when working with topology layers and SFS layers.</p>
