Description

When you open the Add a Raster Layer Dialog: 'Open a GDAL supported Raster Data Source' the 'Files of Type' drop down defaults to select 'AIG GRASS All other files', but the display is actually showing all the [[GeoTiffs]], not 'all files'. In order to see all files I need to select something else in the list and then re-select the AIG GRASS All other files item from the drop down.

Very minor bug, but a bug none the less.
