<p>Steps to reproduce:</p> <p>Open the attached shape file that contains a set of polygons.</p> <p>Select two polygons.</p> <p>Merge the polygons.</p> <p>Select the node tool.</p> <p>Select a vertex.</p> <p>Delete the vertex.</p> <p>Keep selecting and deleting vertices until Qgis crashes.</p> <p>Crashes on my machine at every attempt, but sometimes more, sometimes less vertices have to be deleted.</p> <p>The merge step seems to be necessary to reproduce the bug.</p> <p>The core dump is compressed 72MB and therefore not attached. I will provide the core dump on request.</p>
