<p>Something broke in between point releases of 2.14</p> <p>On 2.14.3 I can import the attached shapefile (as example) with the d&amp;d in Browser into a PostGIS or Spatialite database.</p> <p>On 2.14.9 the d&amp;d to PostGIS returns</p> <p>Failed to import some layers!</p> <p>localidades: Creation of data source "teste1"."localidades" failed: ERROR: syntax error at or near "," LINE 1: CREATE TABLE "teste1"."localidades"( PRIMARY KEY ( ) )</p> <p>On 2.14.3 I can d&amp;d from Spatialite to PostGIS, while on 2.14.9 it fails with the same error as above.</p>
