Description

Create a 1-n relation between 2 files
Then with the identify tool, click on a parent feature.
In the feature form that opens, the children are always listed in the form view mode, regardless the view mode set in Settings --> Options --> Data source --> Default view.
This occurs at every opening of the feature form, even if you last closed it in a table view mode.

Either the global setting is applied to embedded forms or they have their own special setting or they always keep the last state. I'd vote for the first or third option.
