"Orphan record was left in attribute table. Delete the record?"

That is correct. The category (link to record) is deleted immediately from the feature (geometry). Then the vector file is checked if more features are lined to the same record. If not you are asked if the 'orphan' record should be deleted. So if you click on 'No' the record is left in table.
