<p>I'm using QGIS 2.18.2-nightly on windows. I am using the refFunctions plugin to set the default value from an intersecting feature in another layer. If I enter the function in the "edit widget properties" dialog everything works as expected and I get a valid preview. However, If I open the expression widget to build an expression it evaluates the expression as invalid.</p> <p>Eval Error: "'NoneType' object has no attribute 'intersects'"</p> <p>The field calculator does not evaluate the same expression as invalid.</p>
