In standalone python script `from qgis._core import *` produces `ImportError: DLL load failed: The specified module could not be found`

<p>In Windows 7 x64 SP1 using Python 2.7 x64, I installed QGIS 2.14.9 from the standalone x64 installer. I was trying to set up a python virtual environment to develop standalone app (http://gis.stackexchange.com/a/223325/36886). I added the following paths to a .pth file in the environment's site-packages:</p> <pre>C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\qgis-ltr\\python C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\Python27\\ C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\Python27\\Lib\\ C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\Python27\\Lib\\site-packages C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\bin C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\include C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\qgis-ltr\\bin</pre> <p>But when I type <code>from qgis.core import *</code>, python tries to import <code>qgis._core</code> and fails with</p> <pre>ImportError: DLL load failed: The specified module could not be found</pre> <p>Having a look at the <code>qgis/_core.pyd</code> file with DependencyWalker produces the attached output image</p>

Sorry, fired off this issue a little prematurely.

I resolved the import error by adding the following to my PATH variable.

```
C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\apps\\qgis-ltr\\bin
C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen\\bin
```

Though I would highlight that just adding `C:\\Program Files\\QGIS Essen`, as the documentation suggested, didn't work.
