<p>This is kind of a UX bug to me.</p> <p>Have a layer that uses a Categorized or Graduated style.</p> <p>Choose a nice color scale and apply it so that your features are fancy.</p> <p>Screenshot A shows the current style panel. You can see that the Symbol is shown with some green fill here, that's already a bit misleading.</p> <p>Now go to the Symbol Selector menu (Click "Change" next to "Symbol"). You see the same color in a picker. Screenshot B.</p> <p>If you change it, nothing in your style changes. Screenshot c.</p> <p>Same if you change the color directly "deeper down" in the fill itself. Screenshot D.</p> <p>This makes total sense, the fill color is defined by the style's color scale. But it is not intuitive at all. Please remove that color picker or lock it with a text/symbol that says "defined by classes".</p> <p>I am using QGIS for many years now but I still end up confused by this at some days. 8)</p>
