## OGR error on feature: id too large

<p>On a GeoPackage layer with a feature id column ("fid"), it is possible to add features with very long fid (like 4345345453544) but not to delete the feature (or edit the fid). In these cases, QGIS returns a commit error: <b>OGR error on feature 1234*: id too large*</b> (see screenshots attached).</p> <p>Tested on QGIS 2.18.5 and 2.99, W10 x64</p>
