<p>Hi,</p> <p>I have installed QGis 2.14.13 on Windows XP (in a virtual machine) and this works fine.</p> <p>Since version 2.14.14 QGis doesn't work on Windows XP. When launching QGis I have the following message:</p> <p>The procedure entry point GetTickCount64 could not be located in the dynamic link library KERNEL32.dll.</p> <p>This error is due to libcurl.dll that needs this procedure. The 2.14.13 version of QGis provides another version of cUrl that doesn't depend on this procedure. When copying &amp; replacing libcurl.dll from version 2.14.13 to 2.14.14, QGis starts successfully.</p>
