<p>In current master(bfb62c4be9), I cannot add a new WCS service, while I can do that in 2.14 or 2.18</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) click button 'Add WCS Layer'</li><li>2) in dialog click button New</li><li>3) give title: RIVM</li><li>4) give url: <a href="http://geodata.rivm.nl/geoserver/wcs">http://geodata.rivm.nl/geoserver/wcs</a></li><li>5) click OK</li><li>6) the connection is not visible in the dropdown</li></ol> <p>I tried this both with my current .qgis2 config and a fresh one via 'qgis --configpath /tmp/foo'</p> <p>I do not see any indication of misbehaving in debug info or messages</p>

Further checking: if I create a new connection in Browser panel, at least it shows up (see attachment).

BUT look at the 'Dialog title': it says: "Create a new CS/ Connection" ?

And THEN at least THAT connection shows up in the WCS dialog...

Though if I edit it, the URL appears empty...

Trying to add a new one does not work though.

Adding the RIVM one from the opening description works (in the browser!), and then shows up then in the Dialog too. But adding a new one in the browser just does not work.
