Description	
If you want to join 2 shape files on an attribute column, QGIS crashes.	
Workaround: first save (one of) the shape file(s) as csv, then do the join	
Scenario to reproduce:	
1) Open a new project	
2) Add a shape file	
3) Add a second shape file	
4) Go to "Properties" of one of the shape files	
5) On the "Join" tab create a join with the other shape file	
6) Crash.
