<p>On 2 Dell machines using Windows 7, 8, 8.1, and 10 after installing any QGIS version are affected with the issue of the single click on the mouse no longer working properly. I can only get the mouse single click to work within or outside of QGIS by pressing and holding the mouse for much longer than normal. This issue only develops after I install QGIS on a clean windows machine. I have tried a number of fixes for the mouse and drive with no luck.</p>
