<p>When you drag and drop a .jpg image into QGIS it opens it as a Raster, however if the JPEG has a GPS coordinate in its EXIF metadata then I think QGIS should load it as a vector point at that location rather than a raster.</p> <p>I've only tested this in QGIS 2.14, but I couldn't find any existing issues which address this.</p> <p>PS. I'm not sure the best category, but I couldn't leave it blank.</p>
