<b>Description</b>		
Steps to reproduce:		
0: needs a shapefile with a value relation field (e.g. a linked species list) using multiple choices option		
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. set a shapefile layer in editing mode,</li><li>2. open attribute table,</li><li>3. select a feature,</li><li>4. open form view,</li><li>5. go to a value relation field of the attribute form,</li><li>6. select many entries, summing up to a total length longer than the field length</li><li>7. end editing mode and save changes</li></ol>		
Now, check the entry in the attribute table field. The entries will have been cut off on reaching the maximum field length of the attribute.		
Suggested behaviour: <b>Prompt a warning <i>on selection of any surplus attribute</i> in the value relations field, or, if not possible, <i>before saving the shapefile</i> (with option to continue in editng mode w/o saving).</b>
