<p>If one drags and drops a geopackage into QGIS master, the column labeled "Number of features" in the "Select Vector Layers to Add" dialogue is always listing zero.</p> <p>Instead the number of features seem to be listed in the "Layer name" column, separated by a colon. See screenshot attached.</p> <p>In 2.18.x this still worked fine - so seems to be a regression.</p>
