## Description

Hi, I discovered a problem with QGIS (1.0.2 and 1.1). It's slow when zooming big vector layers (either in SHP and Postgis format).

Reproduce it with:

- 1) zoom in to a small region
- 2) zoom in another time

as you can see, QGIS is going to use 100% CPU and remains stuck.
