<b>Description</b>	
<p>The opacity slider for a WMS or XYZ layer it not showed in the legend immediately after added. You need to dag the layer item up or down in order to refresh the panel's gui and see the slider.</p> <p>Steps to reproduce (in both 2.18 and 2.99):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Load a WMS or XYZ layer</li><li>2. Add the Opacity Slider (in Layer properties -&gt; Legend)</li><li>3. No slider is displayed (although the vertical scrollbar seems to notice the legend height change)</li><li>4. Drag the layer down a bit to trigger gui refresh</li><li>5. The slider magically appears</li></ol> <p>Please note both layer types (unlike other layers) have the fold-down triangle visible all the time. So I suspect the layer item doesn't notice the child widget list change.</p>
