<p>When there is only one row shown on attribute table, "Update All" / "Update Filtered" / "Update Selected" button click event doesn't trigger attribute table refresh. Corresponding column gets updated behind the scene, but not shown.</p> <p>affected version: OSGeo4W-qgis-dev-2.18.14-13</p>

If the corresponding layer has only 1 row, all 3 buttons do not trigger refresh.
