<p>After digitizing a new feature in a spatialite based layer, qgis opens the form to enter the data.</p> <p>The field "pkuid" (defined in the db as primary key and autoincrement) contains "NULL" and the save button is grey. You can only activate the save button, if you manually makes an entry in this field. This is not "autoincrement".</p> <p>In 2.18.14, this works correct. In the form, the "pkuid" field is blank and the save button ist aktiv. Press the save button and spatialite db gives the autoincrement number automaticaly.</p>
