<p>Open the DB Manager</p> <p>Select a gpkg database (i didn't test other formats)</p> <p>In Table Menu, select "Create a table"</p> <p>Fill the dialog and click Create</p> <p>You'll see the layer added to the database but the "create new layer" dialog is still open.</p> <p>It should either be open and cleared or closed. (unless it's by design, to help recreate new layers from the previous one? not sure what behavior is better)</p>

I think keeping it open is by design, to allow create other tables without having to reopen the dialog again. In this sense clearing the form make sense to me.

By the way that dialog has **still** the problem (reported in another ticket) that the CRS must be entered manually, it does not open the normal QGIS CRS selector.
