I'm not sure this is expected or no, but since it's nearly impossible to get up-to-date info about 2.99 on the web, here it is:

I get "no Python support" on QGIS 2.99 in the Plugin dialogue. Is that normal?

Compilation from source, the only relevant option I can see in the *cmake* output is:

```
PYTHON_EXECUTABLE /opt/local/bin/python3.6
```

Which is fine.

I wrote a Portfile (for Macports) for it. It pulls out the master version corresponding to a given commit tag. Here is the excerpt of the Portfile:

```
set commit 1c1de3a
github.setup qgis QGIS ${commit}
```

Then the package proceeds through the various configuration, build and installation stages and gives a perfectly functional Qgis3 app (3D works) but for Python support.
