Steps to reproduce:

- 1. Add the attached layer to a new project
- 2. Open the attribute table
- 3. Enable editing
- 4. Select the first row (see attached screenshot1.png)
- 5. Press "delete", now 2 rows have disappeared (see attached screenshot2.png)
