<p>Using ESRI shapefiles and it shows up when deleting records from a table, or cutting/pasting records between a table.</p> <p>If I paste 99 records into an empty table the title bar will show I now have 198 records in the table, filtered 99 records. There is no filter applied to the table (actually impossible to apply a filter to a table in edit mode in 2.18)</p> <p>If toggling the view from Show All Features to Show Selected Features the title bar counts will correct.</p> <p>Not just the title bar counts that are wrong. Have had a table which has 188 records in it, only lets me see 37. Clicking the view as mentioned eventually got me to where it has "filtered = 36" with no actual filter set what so ever</p>
