#### **Description**

- 1. I select a file with multiple layers inside in the Data Source Manager
- 2. I click "add"
- 3. right after add.png
- 4. I think that the first layer is selected as there is some blue in that line so I click Ok.
- 5. The dialog closes and no layer is added.

Instead I needed to explicitly select a layer (which is GOOD but not communicated well). If I click on one, I get a "proper" dark-blue selection (really selected.png).

Suggestions:

Do not highlight anything in the initial state of the dialog

and

Disable the "OK" button until at least one layer is selected.
