<p>In the layer properties --&gt; attribute form tab, select a field and add constraints + check the enforce constraint option: In my case, i checked the options for "not null" and "unique".</p> <p>When creating a feature, the constraints options work well in the form, disabling the ok button when value does not comply with constraint.</p> <p>However, when editing existing field in the attribute table, i can add null value or add an existing value (hence, not unique) and i can save the changes.--&gt; the field does not respect the constraints.</p>
