That's because it's adding the "object\_id" attribute for the atlas feature, not the string literal 'object\_id'. I.e. get the value for the current fearure of object\_id (say, "5"), and then get the attribute from that feature with matching field name (field with name "5").

It's the same behaviour everywhere with expressions.
