**Description**

ENVIRONMENT:

QGIS 3.0.1 on Fedora 26

DATA:

GeoPackage or Shapefile, vector layer, ~70,000 features (US Census tracts)

TO REPLICATE:

1. Open Attribute Table.
2. Toggle editing
3. Select some nontrivial number of features (in my case ~3000)
4. Attempt to update features using a formula (in my case, updating all features where "column\_name" = 'NA' to have the value NULL)

EXPECTED BEHAVIOR:

Values updated

OBSERVED BEHAVIOR:

QGIS hangs, Fedora invites the user to "Force Quit"
