<p>Right now, the complete filename of a GPKG file is shown in front of each layer name.</p> <p>If you now have explanatory filename (which means a longer one), the whole thing becomes difficult to understand, because the complete filename is repeated for each layer.</p> <p>It would be absolutely sufficient if the file name is only displayed in the summarizing group (it is displayed there anyway).</p> <p>Thanks to the properties menu and the mouse-over you can still see which GPKG the layer belongs to.</p> <p>You can even hide this switch in the advanced settings, but it should belong to the project.</p>
