Working on a Mac (if it matters)		
I am developing a new plugin for qgis 3 on a Mac using plugin builder following instructions in the latest version of The PyQGIS Programmer's Guide. I have now got the point where I have compiled the skeleton code and loaded it into QGIS. The plugin appears in the plugin manager as installed.		
The instruction say one must then click the check box to enable the plugin but there are no checkboxes next to the plugin names, just one at the top of the column which is not properly aligned with the text.
