<p>This is a very strange issue I found on QGIS 3.0 and also on QGIS 3.1 (master) on Linux. For some reason, certain tones of gray are not exported correctly to PDF.</p> <p>They work well when converted to JPEG or PNG, but not in PDF.</p> <p>Look at the top corner squares and top elements of the legend of the samples I send.</p> <p>It did not happen with other color ramps, for example, a red to white ramp.</p> <p>There is also a zip with project and data for trying to replicate.</p>
