<p>In the attached image, the New Scratch Layer2 is a line layer to whom I apply the default "effect Neon" line symbol. I would have expected it being more prominent (and not just show something like a point)</p> <p>Testing more: when in the layer properties dialog you set the symbol and apply, the Layers panel looks great until you close the properties dialog and select another layer.</p> <p>Also toggling the layer to edit does not show the pencil icon over the reduced geometry type icon.</p> <p>Occurs also in 3.0</p>
