<p>Using the "Identify Results" tool, right-click on the canvas, you'll be prompted with the list of overlaid features.</p> <p>This is only true if you have the "identify features by area or single click" tool enabled at the top of the Identify Results panel.</p> <p>If you had switched to any other "select" tool, nothing would have happened, either with a single right-click or drawing an extent with the right button pressed (I wonder if the latter process is desirable)</p> <p>Anyway, I think we should either:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- find a way to notify the user that the configs are not good- or allow the right-click button to ignore the active selection tool and still pops-up the result as if it was a single right-click.
