#### **Description**

In QGIS 3.2, the split vector layer tool has the option to output to a temporary folder. But the user has to search through the temporary files on their computer to find the output from this tool. On my computer, I eventually found the output in a folder called C:\Users\...\AppData\Local\Temp\processing\_06d3ebcccd43405387054798e6b8efb9\b215e3c7f0e6409c873c9b7f1d6507bc\OUTPUT. It's not a huge bug, but it gives the impression that this tool simply doesn't work.

This issue would be fixed by adding an option to automatically add the output to the current project.
