<p>So obviously, don't do this... But I accidentally did hide the columns I didn't want deleted and then delete the ones I did want gone. To change several columns behavior at once, unhide a column or change the order of the columns, choose Organize columns .... In the new dialog, you can:</p> <p>check/uncheck columns you want to show or hide...</p> <p>I finally tried creating a new column - which let me unhide the old ones.</p> <p>Somehow I doubt this is a desirable solution, but I couldn't find any others. If it is the only one, maybe add it to the documentation?</p>
