If I extract the content of the qgz (ie ö.qgz) to a folder (creating ö.qgs and ö.qgd) I can open the ö.qgs...</p> <p>qgz vs. qgs:</p> <p>I think it should be possible to choose the default-type of the project-file (qgs or qgz) in the settings as the compressed qgz-files cause problems with our virus-scanners...</p> <p>Thanks</p> <p>Peter</p>
