| <p>Currently we have various places where python code can be typed (project macros, layer actions, expression function panel, python console)</p> <p>One of the most common caveats is mixing the use of whitespaces and tabs which makes the python interpreter fail.</p> <p>That would be neat to apply an autoconvert of tab to whitespaces feature, or like in text editors, offer an option to choose which indentation character is preferred. This is called "Untabify or Tabify" in Atom editor for instance.</p> | | |
