5. Make some changes		
6. Save it to the project again (using the dedicated button)		
7. Close		
8. Reopen the model		
The modifications were not saved.		
<b>Expected results :</b>		
The model should be overwritten, opt. with a confirmation dialog.		
<b>Workarounds :</b>		
Manually delete the previous model before saving or save under another name.
