<p>There is no "out format field" (-of format) in Gdal Translate. Currently, the output format is guessed from the file extension (not obvious for someone used to working at the command line) and a single format is applied by default to all output files.</p> <p>Additional fields like -b band would be very nice to have. Since there are many possible parameters, perhaps an open parameter field would be helpful for this and other gdal tools.</p> <p>https://www.gdal.org/gdal_translate.html</p>
