<b>Description</b>		
<p>I did a lot of georeferencing these days, using one screen for the georeferencer dialog and another one for QGIS main dialog. When adding GCP points, i have to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Click the point on the raster image.</li><li>2. A dialog opens on which i have to select that i want to use the map canvas.</li><li>3. The georeferencer dialog is minimized and i Click the point on the map.</li></ol> <p>When doing a lot of georeferencing, that dialog pop up becomes annoying and results at the end in a lot of clicks. It could be nice to have a setting i'd check that i want to use the map canvas and skip these repetitive clicks: i click the raster and i click the map.</p>
