<p>Create a temporary layer.</p> <p>Add fields to the layer using the attribute table. Yesterday I was convinced the issue resides in the first field being of string type but further tests before I report show that integer can also raise it.</p> <p>Add features with their attributes.</p> <p>In the locator bar, do a search with "af ".</p> <p>Instead of features the layer would return a cryptic [Please define preview text] (no clue on the meaning nor how to fix).</p> <p>The same text is shown in layer properties --&gt; Display tab until you pick a field. Next search in locator won't show that text anymore.</p> <p>PS: looks like creating the field in the layer properties does fill the display name field, thus no message in search.</p>
