I found out why - looking at the Items panel, it showed that there were two maps on the layout and the legend was referencing a spurious empty map that nobody seems to have created (not intentionally anyway), and this seems to have caused a glitch. We right clicked on the extra map, clicked delete, then deleted the legend and added a new legend - and now the filter works.

Thought I would post that in case anyone else has the same issue.
