<p>If the user decides to add QGIS to the launcher favourites, when the user starts the application, two different icons will be at the launcher bar (see attached file).</p> <p>To fix this double entrance in the launch bar, we need to add StartupWMClass=QGIS3 to the desktop file, so it knows that the applications are the same.</p> <p>The desired behaviour is a launch bar with just one icon.</p> <p>I'm submitting a PR to fix this small issue.</p>
