#### Description

When opening a new session of QGIS, The "Recent projects" list will show unavailable/lost project in a grayed color. A right-click over these files allows to refresh (refresh what?) or remove the file from the list.

But there's also an **Open ""...** entry (should be "open directory..." if file was available) that does nothing. It could be nice to deactivate/hide that entry if the file is not accessible and give it a sexy label.
