<p>It would be a good idea to save the layer name in style files.</p> <p>It could be argued that in QGIS 2, without the ability to select which layer characteristics to save, the reusability of a style file would be limited for other layers. But at the latest for QGIS 3, where this choice exists, there should be the possibility to save the layer name with.
