<p>I entered a "layer name" on the WMS layer dialog (very bottom box). Now, no matter which WMS layer I select, it always has that same "layer name" showing, and every layer I add uses that QGIS layer name.</p> <p>Even if I start a completely new project, it remembers my old "layer name", let alone when I simply close and re-open the WMS dialog. The only way to</p> <p>The only way to clear it is either to restart QGIS entirely, or manually delete everything from the field.</p> <p>I'd suggest it should be reset when a new layer is selected.</p>
