<p>DB manager shows an autocomplete box for existing layers. When you press &lt;tab&gt; or double click on an entry, the value doesn't get quoted. For layer <i>New scratch layer</i>, this results in <i>New</i> instead of the correct '<i>New scratch layer</i>'.</p> <p>Please have a look at the attached image.</p>
